

REGULAR MEETING  
ASHLAND CITY COUNCIL

AUGUST 5, 2013

The Ashland City Council met for a regular meeting on August 5, 2013 6:00 P.M. in the Ashland City Hall Auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Bobbie J. Steed, Gail E. Thompson, Rebecca G. Boddie and Brad Wolfe. Also present were City Clerk Charles E. Foster, Asst. City Clerk Donna J. Bennett, Acting Police Chief Cecil Chappell, Maintenance Supervisor Randy Hanners, Asst. Maintenance Supervisor Edward Waldrop, Acting Fire Chief Josh Nelson, Code Enforcement Officer Terry Raughton, Representative Steve Hurst, Emily Nelson and Ray Stansell of the Clay Times Journal.

Council Member Zeola D. Echols and Police Chief Benny Davis were absent.

Mayor Fetner called the meeting to order and Council Member Wolfe gave the invocation.

Council Member Boddie moved to approve the agenda with the addition of Item No. 3 under informational items – Rescheduling of Outdoor Expo and Item No. 1 under other business – Approval of resolution for the municipal court to assess an additional court cost of \$50.00. Motion was seconded by Council Member Wolfe and all votes were unanimous.

Council Member Boddie moved to approve the minutes of the previous planning meeting. Seconded by Council Member Steed and all votes were unanimous.

Council Member Boddie moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Council Member Wolfe seconded this motion and all votes were unanimous.

Under informational items, it was announced that Congressman Mike Rogers will hold a “Congress on Your Corner”, September 4 @ 2:00 P.M. at City Hall.

It was discussed that Council Member Boddie would work to get the amphitheater completed at the park.

Council Member Boddie announced that the Outdoor Expo that was scheduled for August 31 has been rescheduled for April 5, 2014.

Under committee reports, Mayor Fetner reported that he and Council Member Steed would meet on Tuesday to discuss recommendations from AMIC for worker's compensation.

Council Members Steed, Thompson and Boddie did not report.

Council Member Wolfe reported on the children's play recently held in Ashland.

Clerk Foster and Acting Chief Chappell did not report.

Acting Chief Nelson reported that one of the barrel doors at the Fire Station was not working and asked permission to get someone to repair. Permission granted.

Supervisor Hanners thanked Terry Raughton for his for his work on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue South and Highway 9 South, also to SIFAT for the youth that helped to relieve them to work on other projects.

Code Officer Raughton reported on several projects including the work on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue South, completion of one driveway sidewalk on Highway 77 North, paving at the wet well on Highway 9 North and W & W Heating & Air to begin work at Wynn Building this month.

Mayor Fetner called on the Honorable Steve Hurst who spoke briefly on the change in district lines and hopes to be able to help the city after the next election.

Council Member Wolfe moved to approve the bills received since the last meeting in the amount of \$11986.81. Council Member Boddie seconded the motion and all votes were unanimous.

Item No. 2 – Ad for Friday Night Life, died for lack of a motion.

Council Member Thompson moved to reschedule the first council meeting in September to the 3<sup>rd</sup> at the same time due to Labor Day. This motion was seconded by Council Member Boddie and all votes were unanimous.

Council Member Thompson made a motion to allow FACS to use the football facilities at a cost of \$150.00 per game. This motion was seconded by Council Member Steed and all votes were unanimous.

Council Member Wolfe made a motion approving a resolution for the municipal court of the City of Ashland to assess an additional court cost amount of \$50.00 to each court case which will be kept by the city. This motion was seconded by Council Member Thompson and all votes were unanimous.

There being no further business, Council Member Thompson moved to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Council Member Wolfe and all votes were unanimous.
