The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting at 5:30 P.M. on September 21, 2015 in the Ashland City Hall auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Bobbie J. Mayor Fetner called the meeting to order.

Items discussed were proposed contract with Clay County Animal Shelter to house nuisance animals for the City, allowing the Senior Center van to be used at the Car Show in Lineville on November 1, 2015, Ashland will supply a city employee Freddie Alexander to drive the van for insurance purposes. Possibility of security signs at cemetery.

Chief Stanford advised the Police Department is currently handling nuisance animals as needed. Chief Stanford also advised the Police Department may need help from the Maintenance Department with nuisance animals in the future.

Ryan Nelson updated the Council on permits for the Industrial Park on Alabama Hwy 9. The entrance to the Industrial Park will not be where it was originally planned. Mr. Nelson informed the Council ALDOT has allotted \$300,000 for turning lanes that is a special allocation and the City of Ashland will not have to match the allotment.
