The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting at 5:30 P.M. on January 04, 2016 in the Ashland City Hall auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Council Members present were Billy Joe Smith, Bobbie J. Steed, Gail Thompson, Rebecca G. Boddie, and Brad Wolfe. Items discussed included the need for a resolution and committee to apply for grant funds pertaining to the 200 year bicentennial, sports director contract and salary, job description for code enforcement, safety officer, and animal control officer.

Councilman Wolfe expressed the amount of time Mr. Harris put into the program and advised the council that Mr. Harris deserves more money. Councilman Wolfe also expressed he would like to see someone hold the position for more than a year or two.

Jody Brown advised the Council he would like to use the Ashland City Park for a motorcycle show and swap meet on Saturday, April 02, 2016 with a backup date if inclement weather on Saturday April 09, 2016. All Council Members agreed to allow Mr. Brown to use the park on those dates.
