PLANNING MEETING ASHLAND CITY COUNCIL JUNE 06, 2016

The Ashland City Council met for a Planning Meeting at 5:30 P.M. on June 06, 2016 in the Ashland City Hall auditorium with Mayor Larry J. Fetner presiding. Mayor Fetner called the meeting to order. Items discussed included guidelines for the City Maintenance limb truck route. Maintenance Supervisor Jeremy Nash advised some are taking advantage of this service and requested a set of guidelines. Mayor Fetner and Council Members discussed a set of guidelines for the limb truck route which included the following: the City can only pick up leaves, shrub clippings and limbs, leaves must be bagged and placed on the curb, shrub clipping (if small enough) can be bagged, shrub clippings and tree limbs must be no longer than 10 feet in length and must be laid parallel to the curb, debris must be put at curbside and should not be placed under power lines or on water meters, and the City will not pick up any debris from private property. Council Member Thompson suggested raising the costs for additional loads. Chief Stanford advised the Police Department will be happy to assist the Maintenance Department with traffic control while running the limb pickup route in any areas that are a safety concern. Mayor Fetner and Council Members present also discussed brick sales, and City flag design.
